The new deadline for the submission of proposals is **April 1, 2019**.

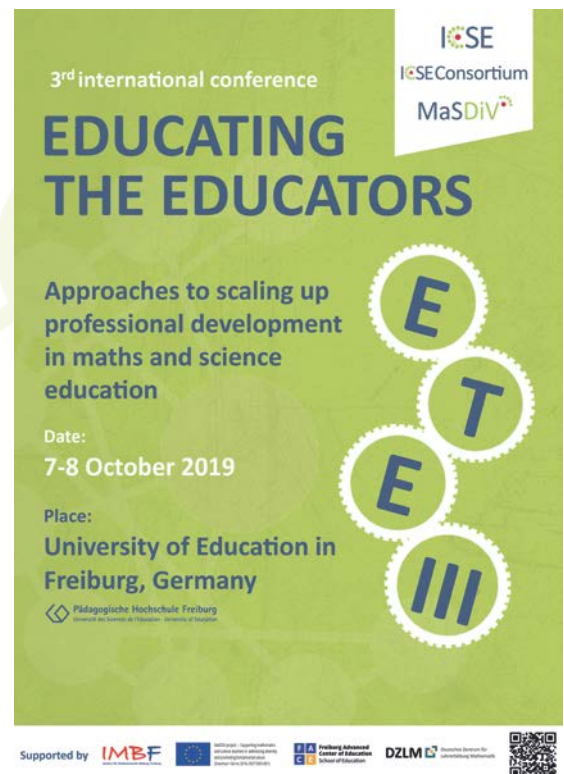
Until that day, we are looking forward to receiving your contributions for the following conference formats:
